NEW CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT:

All of the above will be addressed through the development of an exciting new curriculum currently under development, which makes the subject areas more

meaningful and useful to our students, for their level of need and understanding.

1. Managing Finances: *Money; budgets; financial decisions.*
2. Maintaining a Household: *House keeping; household tasks; living away from home; planning, purchasing and preparing food; storing food.*
3. Maintaining Personal Needs: *Dressing appropriately; health care; personal hygiene; physical fitness and nutrition.*
4. Staying Safe: *road safety; stranger danger; identifying risk and hazards; follow simple safety rules.*
5. Being a Responsible Citizen: *community projects; knowing what communities they belong to; volunteering.*
6. Enjoying Leisure and Recreational Activities: *Group and individual activities; can choose activities to participate in; social events; holidays; hobbies, music, sports.*
7. Travelling within the Community: *Road safety; experiencing public transport.*
8. Achieving Self Awareness: *Emotional; physical; psychological; identifying interests and abilities.*
9. Growing in Self Confidence: *Accepts praise and criticism; confidence and self worth; appropriateness in social situations.*
10. Becoming Independent: *taking responsibility; coping with changes; friendships; increasing independence.*
11. Communicating with Others: *Demonstrate listening and responding skills; social and conversational skills; verbal and non verbal; empathy and sympathy.*
12. Exploring Outcomes: *jobs and responsibilities; work experience; occupational needs; making choices.*
13. Demonstrating appropriate habits and behaviours: *following instructions and accepts supervision; working with others; working to best of ability; pride in what they do.*
