These sessions contained a lot of information about how to help students get the most out of the internet and social networking while staying safe and being responsible.

She introduced us to a wide range of resources including:

- how to use the settings on Facebook, Instagram and other social networks to restrict who can access information about young people
- how to talk to young people about online “friendships”
- how to report concerns about online content or illegal activity
- how to install parental controls through the internet provider
- how to help young people learn about being responsible and safety-conscious when online
- recent changes to how technology is used
