## School Outreach Project

This exciting new initiative started this September. We are currently working in a number of Primary and Middle schools (and could be available for High schools). We aim to fit our service according to the needs of individual schools – an initial contact would establish the schools priorities and a Service Level Agreement is signed outlining the support needed, duration and the cost. I think our service is different because we are both working practitioners and spend most of our week in our own classes. We therefore appreciate the difficulties that are involved in daily school life and aim to help deliver a personalised package.

Some of the areas we can support with include:-

- SEND documentation / paperwork for pre Ofsted monitoring and preparation
- Parent conversations and EHCP conversions
- Support for SENCO's
- Pupil observations / tracking / ideas for differentiation
- Supporting classes for specific children by suggesting strategies / resources
- Staff training (a variety of areas including Autism, behaviour management, communication, signalong, areas of the curriculum).
- Specialist training days e.g. on PE with pupils with Autism, dyslexia training

Any other areas can be discussed with our Team.

As part of signing a Service Level Agreement we welcome people to look around our school and see our practice. We hope to establish a regular support meeting for staff to share ideas and have training. We also aim to explore the possibilities of some inreach work.
