In key stage 3 we assess individually for a base line assessment and produce individual targets with next steps. These are regularly shared with staff, parents and carers, other professionals and students.

We also do teacher assessments that form part of the schools assessment tool, pupil asset. These take place three times a year and are scrutinised by departmental staff and the senior leadership team.

Key Stage 3 staff takes part in regular moderation tasks to help with more accurate assessment.

We enter individual student data for the end of Key Stage 2 students within Middle School. This is a national requirement.

Interventions take place in Maths and English where students are assessed and identified as needing extra time to achieve their targets. The identified students take part in a specialised program to help them achieve their targets and improve their skills.
