Dear All,

We have completed our first full week back and whilst we now have some tired children, (and staff!) it has been an absolute delight to welcome you all back. I know that staff have been in contact with many of you via do-jo, answering your concerns or worries during this week and I hope that this communication has been helpful. A reminder to all that do-jo messages should be responded to within school hours and may not be able to be responded to until the next working day.

We all have such high hopes for this new academic year with disruption to learning kept to a minimum but none of us can be complacent about the continued threat of Covid - 19 and as such we are keeping some of our covid precautions in order to protect pupils and staff (such as continuing to sanitise on entry and at regular times during the time and staff continuing to wear masks in communal areas where they are able to). We ask that you continue to play your vital part and continue with lateral flow tests twice a week where appropriate. If we have a positive case within school, and your child is a close contact, we will follow the national guidance issued and strongly recommend that your child or young person takes a PCR test.

We are delighted that some after school clubs, in particular, sports clubs, begin next week. We are hopeful that we will be able to extend these clubs as the weeks move onwards depending on the covid situation at the time.
