<p>Throughout the NOCN Using Employability Skills Qualification students will develop their numeracy through the development of their portfolios and work experience. They will be taught how to apply the maths skills they have previously developed through context and real-world applications. All students participating in the NOCN qualification will complete the unit- Using Number Skills in the Workplace.</p> <p>There will be a particular focus on financial literacy, projects, and time management. In Horticulture and Catering, measuring skills will also be a focus, as appropriate.</p> <p>In work experience, students will (where appropriate) be taught how to use till systems, phone systems, email, online shopping, research and other appropriate systems. They will be supported in applying for or managing a bank account, and how their financial experiences will change when they turn 18.</p>
